What are cookies?

Cookies are files that are downloaded to your computer when you access certain web pages. Cookies allow a web page, among other things, to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or his computer and, depending on the information they contain and how their equipment is used, can serve to recognize it.

However, these media only obtain information related to the number of pages visited, the city to which is assigned the IP address from which it is accessed, the number of new users, frequency and recurrence of visits, visiting time, the browser or the operator or type of terminal from which the visit is made. In any case cookies do not contain data such as the name, surname, postal address or other similar data of the user accessing the website.

What are the different types of cookies?

There are own cookies and third-party cookies. Own cookies are those that are sent to the user's equipment from a computer or domain managed by the own editor of the Web, from which the service requested by the user is provided. Third party cookies are those that are sent to the user's equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher, but by another entity that handles the data obtained through cookies.

Additionally, there are session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are a type of cookies designed to gather and store data while the user accesses a web page. Persistent cookies are a type of cookies where data are stored on the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a specific period of time defined by the cookie manager, which can span from a few minutes up to several years.

What types of cookies does our website use?

This website is using own cookies to identify the user, to ensure the correct functioning of the website and to remember the browser preferences, such as the language in which the website is displayed.

This website is using the following third-party cookies:

- Analytics cookies: These cookies are either handled by us or by third parties, they allow us to quantify the number of users, to examine their browsing, and to obtain statistical measurements and analyses of how users use our website. For this purpose we analyse the browsing on our website in order to improve the content of the same and to provide a better service through it.
- Advertising cookies: These cookies enable in the most effective way the management of the advertising blocks which may be integrated on a web page, in an application or on a platform, from which it provides the requested service, based on criteria such as edited content or the frequency at which the advertisements are displayed.
- Cookies for social networks: These cookies facilitate and monitor the connection and the publication of content between this website and the social networks.
